State requirements for requalification are **no LESS than 4 months apart nor MORE than 6 months apart**. Two (2) requalifications must be completed each year in the life of the 2-year permit.

WARNING: If the guard exceeds 6-months between requalifications, even by a single (1) day, the guard must start over entirely with a new exposed firearms permit. There is **NO GRACE PERIOD** with an exposed firearms permit.

"A BSIS Firearms Permit expires two years from the date of issuance. In order to renew the permit, the applicant must: have completed two (2) range qualifications on a firing range every twelve (12) months and at least four (4) months apart. Applicants must complete four (4) total range qualifications prior to renewal of the Firearms Permit at a Bureau-approved firearm training facility and from a Bureau-approved firearm training instructor. All range qualifications must be certified by a Bureau-approved Firearms Training Facility." - BSIS Firearms Permit Fact Sheet.
